Resolution NCR18-02
Resolution to replace JCR #49 General Conference/National Conference

Wherefore, JCR #49 improperly encourages the formation of National Conferences; and

Wherefore, JCR #49 improperly calls for the Joint Conference of Restoration Branches to convene a U.S. National Conference in October in Independence, Missouri for all branches and missions in the United States; *therefore*

Be it Resolved, that JCR #49 be amended by substitution, as follows:

1. The General Conference shall encourage and assist branches in close proximity to form districts.
2. The General Conference shall lend assistance by providing training and presiding ministers for organizational meetings.
3. Resolutions approved at district conferences may be forwarded to the General Conference secretary for consideration by the General Conference.
4. Minutes and/or reports of District Conference activities shall be forwarded to the General Conference Secretary for publication in the General Conference notebook and on the General Conference website.
5. An international General Conference of the church will be convened annually, in April, in the Center Place, where the entire church shall come together to direct the work.

Resolution to cease convening of US National Conference and
replace it with a US National Reunion
submitted by Doug Patterson and Randy Vick

Whereas, there is no scriptural basis for the establishment of or functioning of National Conferences; and

Whereas, conferences authorized by scripture and church law are branch, district, stake and general conferences; *therefore*

Be it Resolved, that the US National Conference forward a resolution to the General Conference in 2019 to amend JCR #49 to remove any mention of national conferences; and

Be it Further Resolved, that pending the amending of JCR #49 by the General Conference of 2019, the US National Conference will cease to convene as an annual conference; and

Be it Further Resolved, that at this National Conference, one of the last orders of business will be to establish a US "national reunion" committee, in anticipation of the amending of JCR #49, to organize a reunion to be held sometime after April in 2019 and annually thereafter if desired.

Be it Further Resolved, that this resolution go to the General Conference in the Spring of 2019 for further consideration and possible adoption.
